Gilbert F. White Collection

Biographical Information

From the early 1930s as a budding geography graduate student, Dr. Gilbert F. White was a leading force in natural resource management and global environmental conservation. Through his dedicated efforts with private and public institutions and his multiple publications White revolutionized the way land managers developed floodplain areas; and brought to the forefront the environmental impact of nuclear war, which led to nuclear non-proliferation negotiations between the United States and the former Soviet Union. He was also active in the promotion of geography in public school curriculums.

Gilbert F. White was born on November 26, 1911, in Chicago, Illinois. He attended the University of Chicago from which he received his bachelor, master's, and doctorate degrees. While still in graduate school in 1934, White was approached by the government to serve as a secretary to the Mississippi Valley Committee of the Public Works Administration. The research White conducted for the committee led to his dissertation, *Human Adjustment to Floods: A Geographical Approach to the Flood Problem in the United States*, which stated his recommendations for the use and protection of floodplain land. White's idea was simple; instead of trying to control waterways and floodplains with dams, the flood prone areas should be ~~left~~ ^{left} ~~undeveloped~~ ^{used to non-} ~~undeveloped~~. His simple yet effective suggestions still reverberate in the field of floodplain management to this day.

From the late 1930s until 1942, White continued working for the government serving as secretary to the Water Resources Committee of the National Resources Committee (later renamed the National Resources Planning Board) and with the Bureau of the Budget. During this time the United States officially entered World War II. As a Quaker, White abstained from active military duty as a conscientious objector; however, he participated in relief work in France with the American Friends Service Committee. He was ^{interned} ~~captured~~ by the Nazis in 1943 ~~and was~~ ^{and a few} ~~interned~~ in the German diplomatic detention center at Baden-Baden for a year. After his release, White returned to the United States; however, at wars end he went back to Europe to report on food supplies.

In 1944, White married Anne E. Underwood (a ~~geographer and~~ behavioral scientist) who would work on several collaborative projects with her husband throughout their careers. They would go on to have three children.

As White's personal life began to expand, so, too, did his career. He became president of the Quaker school, Haverford College, in 1946 and held that position until 1955. He later went on to work at his alma mater, the University of Chicago, as a professor of geography from 1956 to 1969. He would continue building his career in academia at the University of Colorado where he became director of the school's Institute of Behavioral Science.

During his tenure at Colorado, White applied his skills in, and knowledge of, natural hazard research to a new undertaking and founded the Natural Hazards Research Applications and

Information Center in the mid-1970s. He was the organization's director from 1976 to 1984 and again from 1992 to 1994.

Throughout his career White served on numerous boards and committees focused on flood control, water resources issues, environmental conservation, education in geography, and nuclear proliferation. Some of these organizations included the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) advisory committees, the Scientific Committee on Problems of the Environment of the International Council of Scientific Unions (SCOPE), the U.S. National Committee for Man and Biosphere (MAB), and the Steering Committee for High School Geography Project.

Anne Underwood White died in 1989 after battling cancer. Despite his loss, White continued to contribute his years of experience and expertise through editorials, interviews, multiple committee activities, and as Gustavson Distinguished Professor Emeritus of the Institute of Behavioral Science at the University of Colorado.

Processing Procedures

The CEHO Archives now contain two groups of records documenting Gilbert F. White's career. The records described in this finding aid were not inter-filed with the previous collection although the box numbers run continuously. However, many subject headings appearing in the Subject Files series described in this finding aid parallel those created for the initial group of White material. A subject index to the initial accession can be found at the end of this finding aid. The index provides access to the finding aid for the initial accession. Books and other publications directly related to material within the collection were kept with relevant documents. Additionally, books belonging to White are housed in both the CEHO Archives and the Institute for Water Resources' Arthur Maass - Gilbert F. White Reference Room. The books in the CEHO Archives are catalogued in the HECSA library catalog.

Most foreign language documents have some form of translation or descriptive information included.

Photographs and slides were not segregated from related material. For preservation purposes photographs were rehoused with acid-free paper or Mylar™ sleeves. Slides not housed in appropriate sheets were rehoused with acid-free paper. Preservation copies of newspaper articles were made on acid-free paper.

Documents with sensitive information were copied with acid-free paper and redacted when possible. The original documents and other restricted items were separated from the collection. Separation sheets indicate when records were removed.

After processing was complete, an additional group of publications was added to the collection. Rather than interfile these titles into the appropriate boxes (which would have necessitated shifting entire sections of the collection), the titles are *listed* in the appropriate section of the finding aid, but are *housed* in separate boxes. Scope and Content

The Gilbert F. White collection contains material primarily related to White's career. The collection includes correspondence, books, journal articles, clippings, conference papers, speeches, manuscripts, notes, memoranda, meeting material, applications, maps, resumes, ballots, photographs, and slides. The majority of the collection covers three broad subjects: floodplains, water resources, and natural hazards. Other subjects covered include geography education, Quakerism, nuclear proliferation, and general environmental issues.

The collection is divided into four series organized chronologically and/or alphabetically. Most of the material does not address White's early career, before the publication of his dissertation, except for one folder in the Correspondence series. The folder contains original memos and reports by White concerning his work with the Mississippi Valley Committee. References to White's personal life are limited. White's prolific writing career is well documented within the collection and the Writings series, is organized into five sub-series.

The collection is divided into four series as follows

- I. Biographical Material, 1945-1997
- II. Correspondence, 1969-2000
- III. Subject Files, 1917-2002
- IV. Writings, 1935-2002

Series Descriptions

I. Biographical Material, 1945 – 1997

18 folders

This series includes biographical sketches, vitae, awards, photographs, interviews, and articles. Of significant importance is an original copy of White's groundbreaking dissertation, *Human Adjustment to Floods: A Geographical Approach to the Flood Problem in the United States*, in which he discusses his various recommendations for floodplain management. Included in the series is a brief obituary of White's wife, Anne Underwood White, and his vita from 1989 and 1992.

II. Correspondence, 1969 – 2000

1 linear foot

This series includes letters, memos, and accompanying material primarily focused on White's career. Very little personal correspondence is present. Of significant importance is a series of letters from 1934 concerning White's involvement with the Mississippi Valley Committee. Also of interest are four folders containing correspondence related to various book reviews White wrote during the 1970s and 1980s.

III. Subject Files, 1917 – 2002

19.25 linear feet

This series includes correspondence, meeting material, notes, papers, research material, photographs, slides, clippings, and legislative documents. Subject headings derive from specific organizations or broad subject matter that interested White. Of significant importance are the "Natural Hazards Research Applications Workshop" folders that contain material from the Natural Hazards Research Applications and Information Center founded by White. Also of some importance is material on White's human rights activities. Information can be found in folders: "Anti-War/Human Rights Activism" 1 through 3, "Education; University of Chicago – Student Unrest," and "National Academy of Sciences – Committee on Human Rights."

Where possible subject headings correlate with those in the previously processed White material located in the CEHO archives. These subjects include Floodplains, Lower Mekong, Man and Biosphere Program, Natural Hazards, Water & Sanitation, Water Resources, and World Bank. Gilbert White donated his files to the CEHO at varying times. A large group of processed material existed prior to CEHO's receipt of the files described in this finding aid. Where possible, subject headings used in the first group are employed in this finding aid. A subject index to the original collection can be found as an appendix to this finding aid.

The series is arranged by subject and chronologically within each subject.

IV. Writings, 1935 – 2002

This series is divided into five subseries. Three of the five (A. Citations, 1949-1998; B. Joint Authorship, n.d., 1949-2002; and E. Sole Authorship, n.d., 1935-2002) taken together comprise the entire scope of White's professional writing activity. The remaining two subseries concern White's public speaking activities and his work on Quakerism. Each subseries is arranged chronologically.

A. Citations, 1949–1998

1 linear foot

This subseries contains books, articles, correspondence, and other accompanying material that discuss, list, or refer in some way to Dr. Gilbert White. There are at least three articles that discuss the contributions White made to the scientific community: "Geographical Science Abroad Research of Gilbert White and Their Continuation, 1986," "The Contributions and Influences of Gilbert F. White to Integrative Geographic Inquiry, 1986," and "Common Themes in the Work of Gilbert White and John Dewey: A Pragmatic Appraisal, 1992."

B. Joint Authorship, n.d., 1949-2002

2 linear feet

This subseries contains books, articles, correspondence, and other accompanying material that focus on White's collaborative efforts with individuals (including his wife Anne) and organizations. White's 1972 book, *Drawers of Water: Domestic Water Use in East Africa*, is of some significance and was researched and written as a joint effort with Anne White and David J. Bradley.

C. Public Speaking, n.d., 1938-2000

2.50 linear feet

This subseries contains speeches, interviews, articles, conference papers, correspondence, and other accompanying material that document White's speaking engagements. Some of the

speeches and numerous conference papers were later published. An item of some significance is White's contribution to the proceedings of the National Zoning Conference in 1938, where he spoke on floodplain zoning.

D. Quakerism, 1949-1999

.25 linear foot

This subseries contains publications, speeches, articles, and other relevant material concerning White's involvement with the Quakers.

E. Sole Authorship, n.d., 1935-2002

4 linear feet

This subseries contains books, articles, papers, unpublished works, and other related material solely written or edited by White. An item of significance is the publication, *Science and the Future of Arid Lands*.
