When you offset your carbon footprint, you're saying YES to helping people and the planet!

A carbon offset is a voluntary donation that helps fund tree planting and clean cookstove construction in climate vulnerable locations in Central America. Offset your flight's emission at treeswaterpeople.org/co2

Offset by distance traveled:
\$10 for National - short flights
\$15 for National - long flights
\$20 for International flights



Our Central American projects plant trees and build fuel-efficient clean cookstoves, reducing the amount of CO₂ in the atmosphere by sequestering carbon dioxide as the trees grow and reducing the amount of fuelwood needed when cooking.
