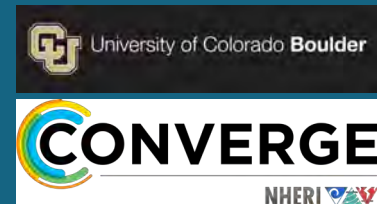

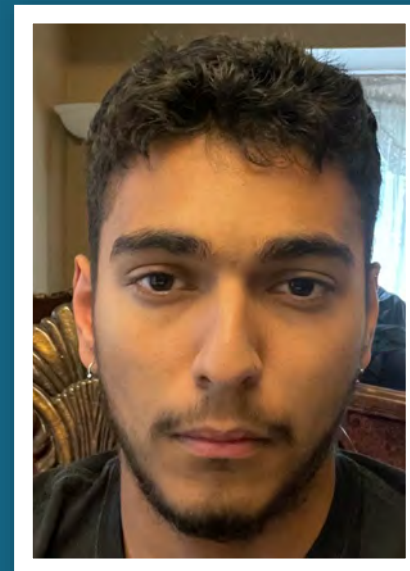

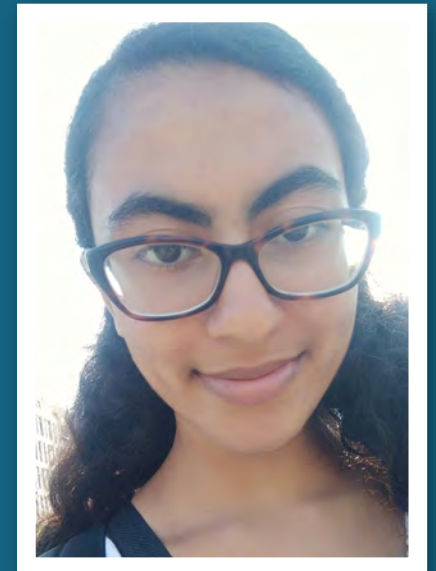

Why State Hazard Mitigation Plans and Social Vulnerability?

1

Understand how **social vulnerability** (and related terms) is conceptualized.

2

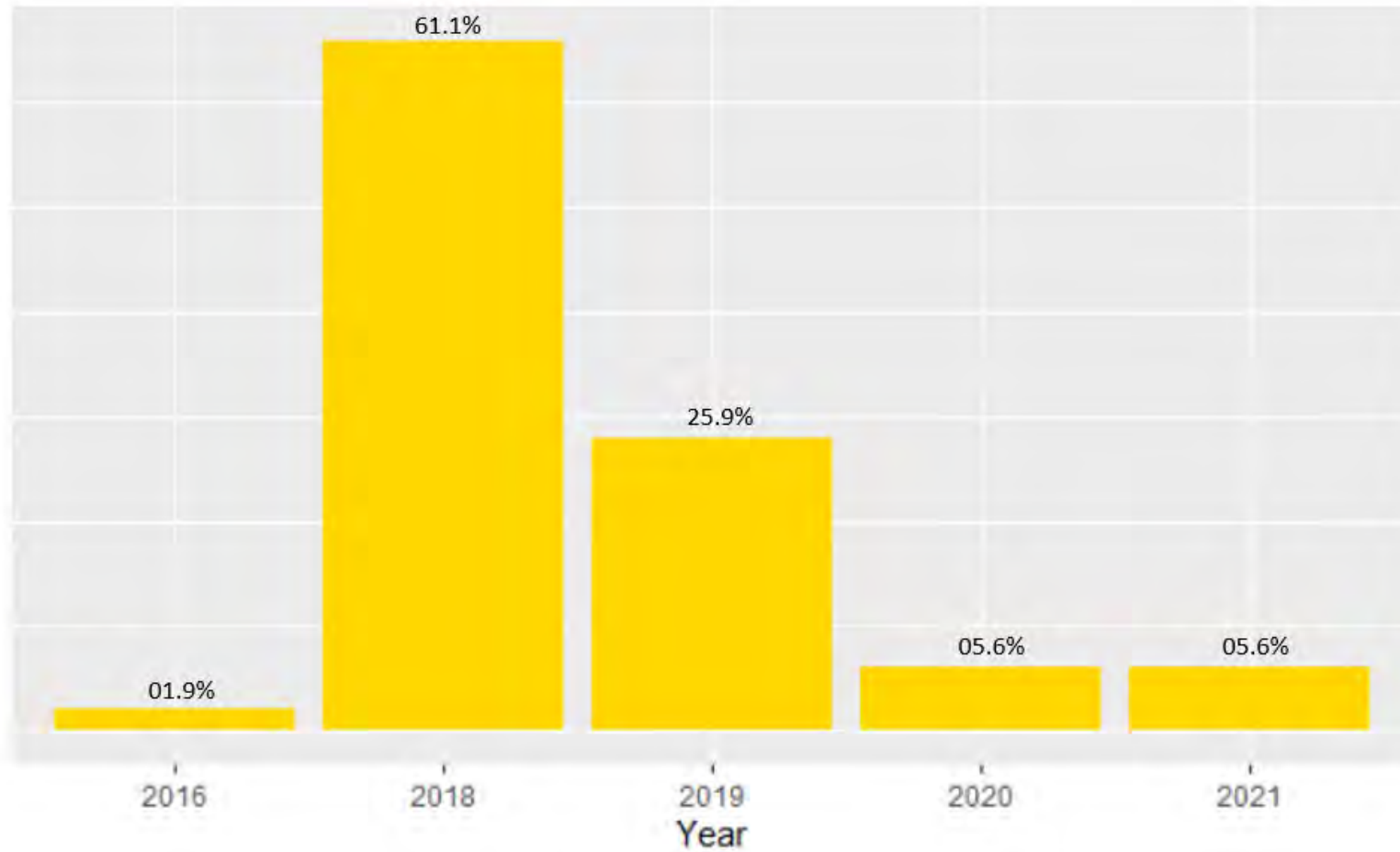
Assess which potentially **vulnerable populations** are included – or excluded – in the plans.

3

Review which **social vulnerability indices, tools, and data sources** are used to spatially locate, describe, or otherwise more robustly characterize the status of these populations.

Why Now?

Nearly two-thirds (61%) of SHMP's were approved in 2018, and another one-quarter (25%) were approved in 2019. With new FEMA guidance around equitable planning, this is an important time to understand how social vulnerability and vulnerable populations have been included in the past.

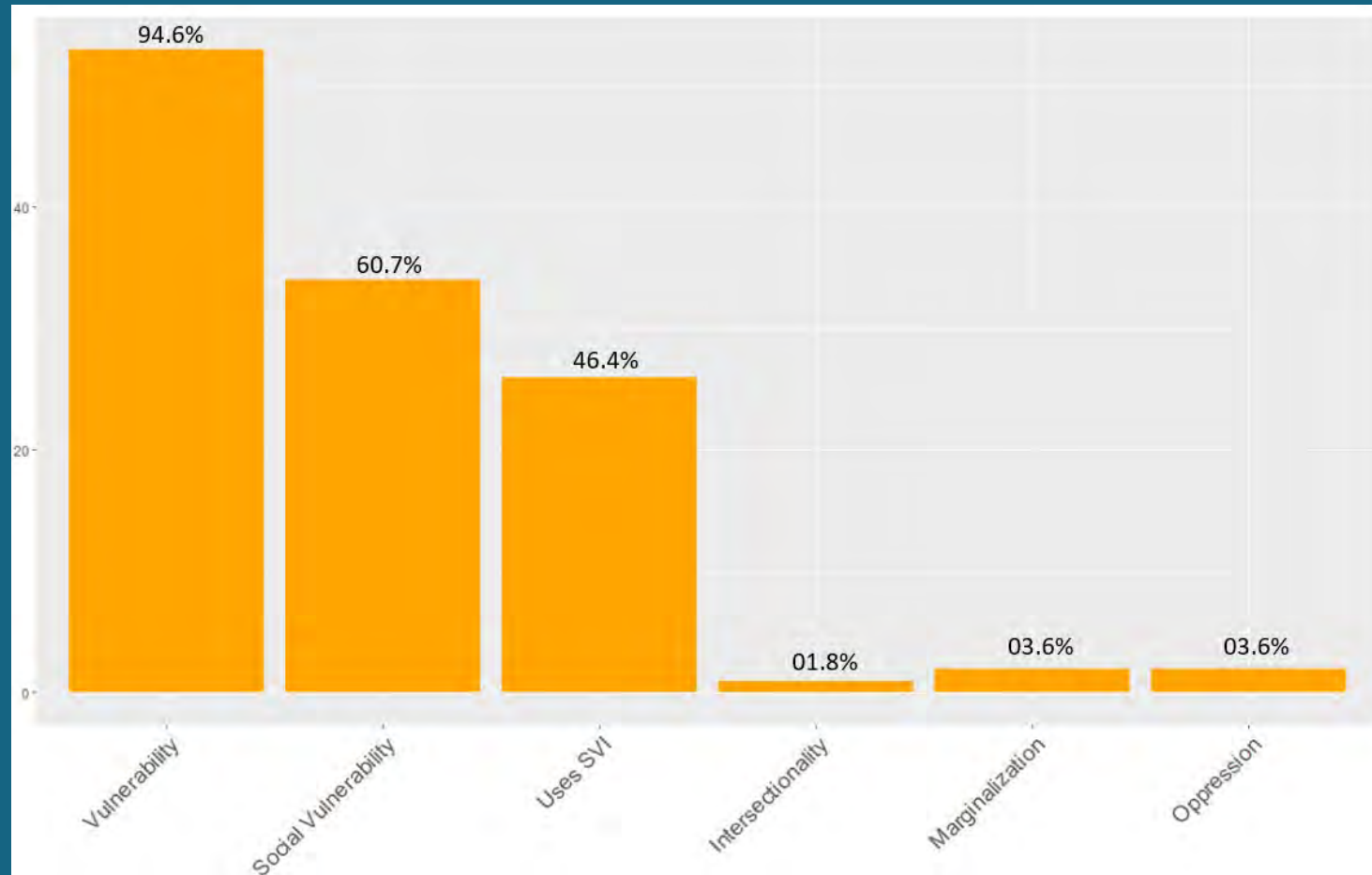
How is Social Vulnerability Defined in SHMPs?



Some states define **social vulnerability**, pulling from established definitions of institutions that measure vulnerability through indices, such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC SVI) or the Hazard & Vulnerability Research Institute (SoVI).

Other states use different terms to define social vulnerability, like “**population vulnerability**” or “**vulnerable communities**” and include a much smaller defined group of people.

Frequency of References to Vulnerability



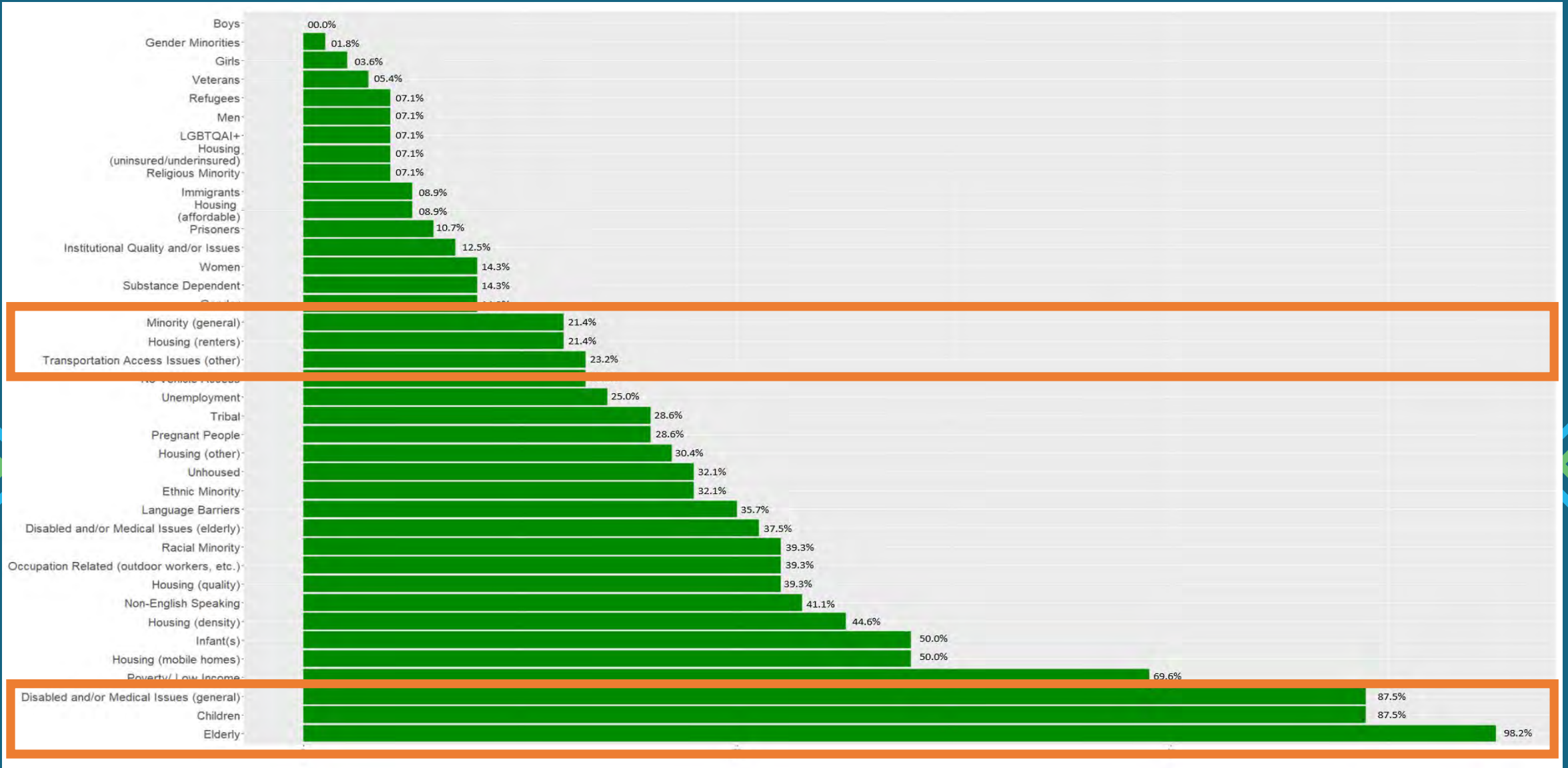

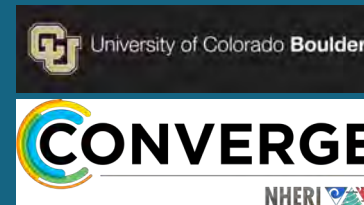

“Social vulnerability to disasters refers to “the characteristics and situation of a person or group that influence their capacity to anticipate, cope with, resist, or recover from the impact of a hazard” (Wisner et al. 2004). [...] The concept of social vulnerability helps explain why communities often experience a hazard differently, even when they experience the same amount of physical impacts. The pre-existing social conditions that contribute to disaster losses can be identified using social vulnerability indicators.” (Colorado, 2-13)

Takeaways

- As states and territories begin the process (or continue updating) their plans, these findings can be useful to think about the range of ways that **social vulnerability and vulnerable populations can be integrated**.
- Not every state or territory includes the same vulnerable populations. There are tools and indices that can help states to make their plans more specific and equitable when it comes to vulnerable populations.
