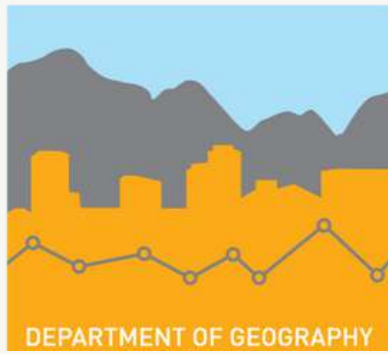


Community Lead Fire Brigade

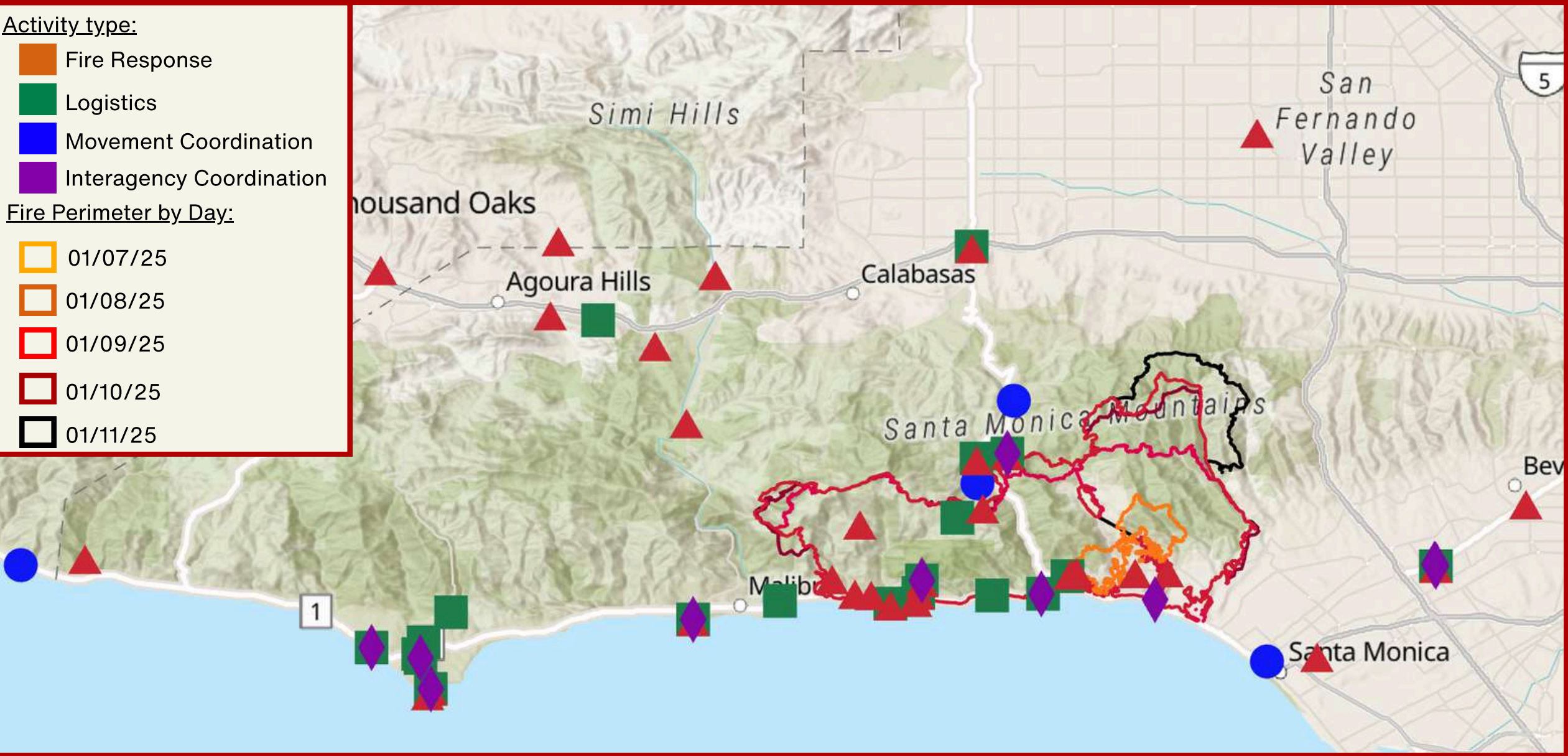
